

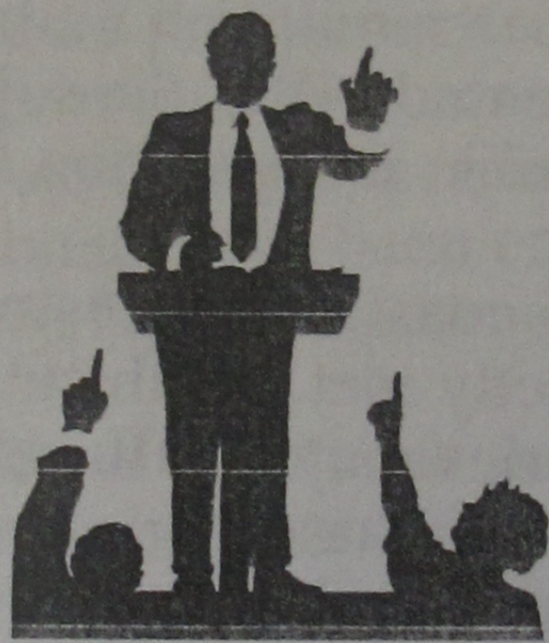
## Poster and Slide Show Production In Progress!

## Attention All Gwitchin Members: Volunteers Are Still Needed!



The Caribou Coordination Department is gearing up for another public education tour. **Volunteers are needed!** There will be one, possibly two tours taking place. In the last edition of the *Caribou Comment*, it was stated that these tours would likely take place in the late summer/early fall of this year. **Due to the present gearing-up which is taking place in preparation for the US elections by political parties and non-governmental organizations alike, it has been decided that these tours will be re-scheduled for early 1997.** The newly scheduled times are as follows:

1. *A tour to Washington.* This 2- to 3-week trip will occur early in 1997. Work here will be done with the assistance of the Alaskan Wilderness League and possibly the Sierra Club.
2. *Accompanying Lenny Kohm on his Last Great Wilderness Tour.* Funding for a 2- to 3-month public education tour is presently in the works. This tour will likely begin early next year (January/February). We need many individuals who are willing to travel for 2- to 3- weeks each to speak for their people and the caribou on this very important issue!
